

Seasonal Trail and BaseCamp Maintenance

Overview:

- Working as a member of the crew, this role focuses on routine, seasonal maintenance at the main trailhead and BaseCamp campground, as well as maintaining our summer trail system. This role includes both landscaping maintenance as well as routine cleaning and maintenance of our camping and lodging facilities including cleaning and preparing cabins for upcoming guests.

Qualifications:

- Position is suitable for well-qualified candidates as young as 14 years old.
- Physically fit and able to carry and use equipment and hand tools.
- Capable of standing and performing repetitive tasks for extended periods of time and working an average of 8-10 hours/day.
- Previous landscaping and/or trail building experience is preferred.
- Enjoy working outdoors in a team environment.
- Previous mountain biking experience.

Trail Building Responsibilities

Trail and Facilities Maintenance

- Perform routine seasonal maintenance to maintain current trails to WinMan's high level of standards.
- Main trailhead landscaping including routine mowing, weed whacking, and outside maintenance as needed.

Equipment Operation and Maintenance

- Capable of learning to safely use power equipment including plate compactor, riding lawn mower, and weed whackers.

Safety and Communication

- Follow all safety protocols to protect oneself, coworkers, and the public.
- Work closely with the trail crew and other team members to execute project plans.

BaseCamp Camping and Lodging Responsibilities

Trail and Facilities Maintenance

- Main trailhead and campground landscaping including routine mowing, weed whacking, and outside maintenance as needed.
- Splitting and stacking firewood for visitors, cleaning fire pits and preparing campsites for new guests, and assisting with full-time staff with any necessary maintenance or building projects.

Housekeeping and Cleaning Maintenance

- Cleaning and preparing cabins for upcoming guests including sweeping and mopping, wiping down surfaces, cleaning bathrooms, and other tasks as needed to ensure a quality first impression for all guests.
- Preparing the cabin for visitors including changing keyless code and restocking any broken or missing items as needed.
